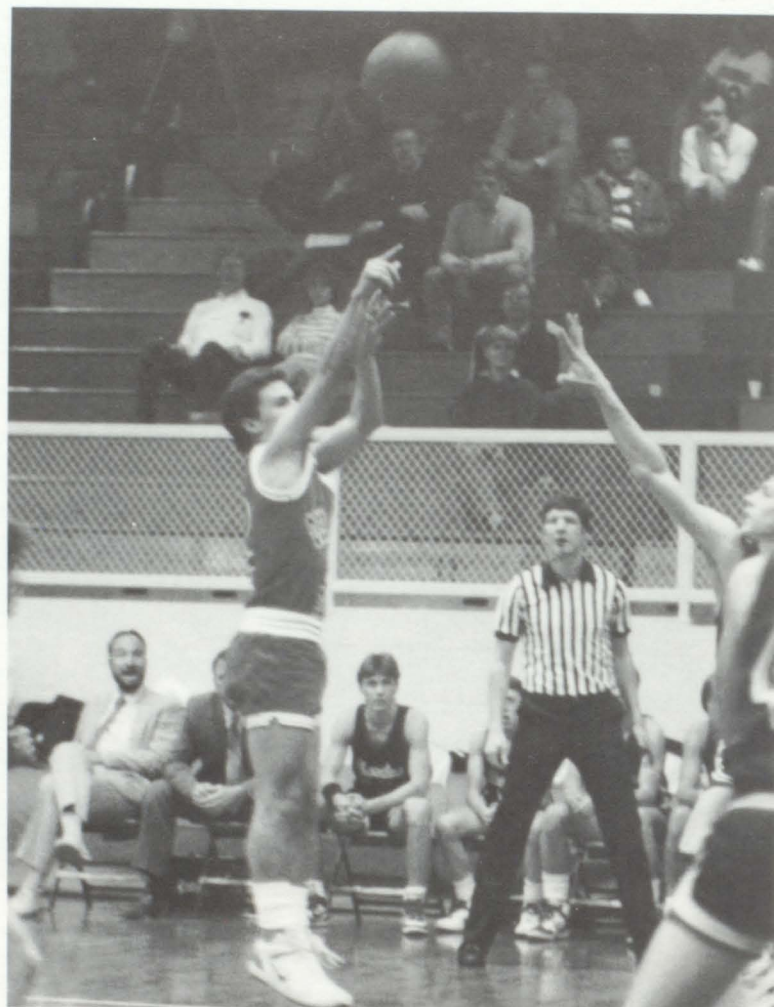




# HOOPS WINS CONSISTENTLY

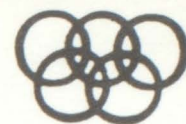
