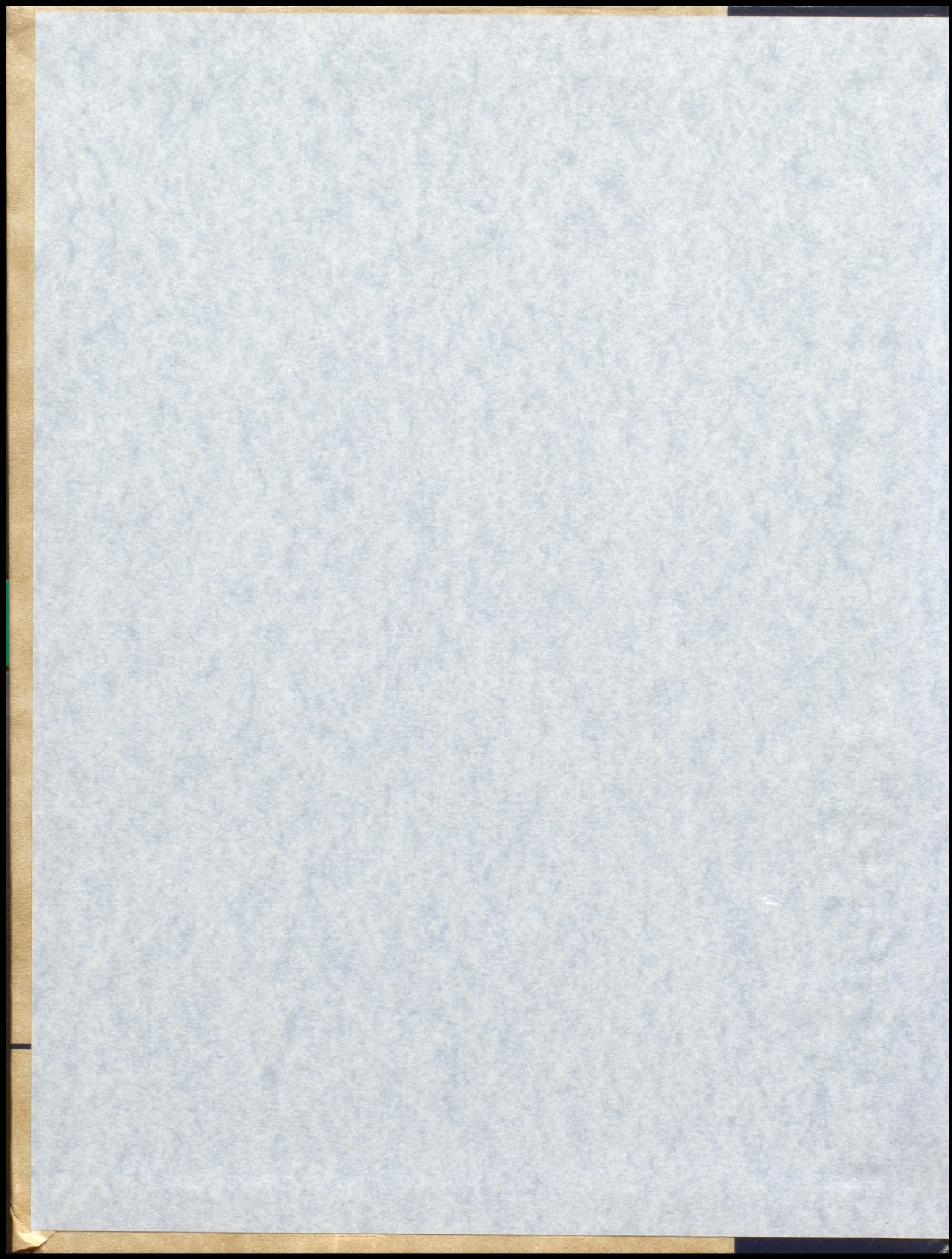

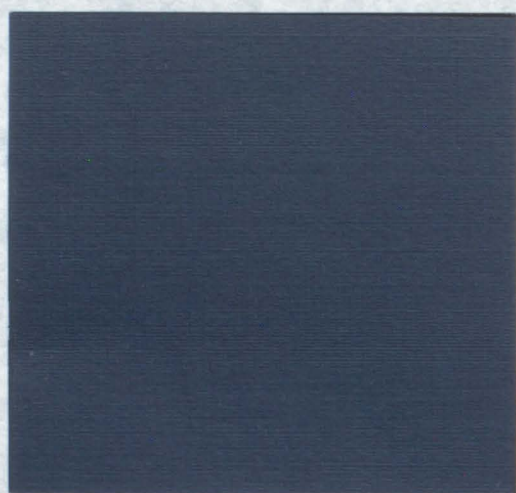

# Chagrin Valley Police Briefs

## *Students Caught Living On The Edge*

565 Chagrin Falls High School Students were caught Wednesday night *living on the edge*. Consistently at the top of their game, these students were convicted of being *nationally ranked* for athletics. The Football and Boys' Soccer teams, as well as Track and Girls' Basketball, were cited for potential State Championships. Once interrogated, the students were also found guilty of *outstanding achievement* in academics. Included in their record was the offense of "attending a nationally ranked school of excellence....[along with] over 90% of the senior class passing Senior Proficiencies." *Principal Dr. David Axner* was interviewed and commented on the condition of the environment the students are exposed to daily. 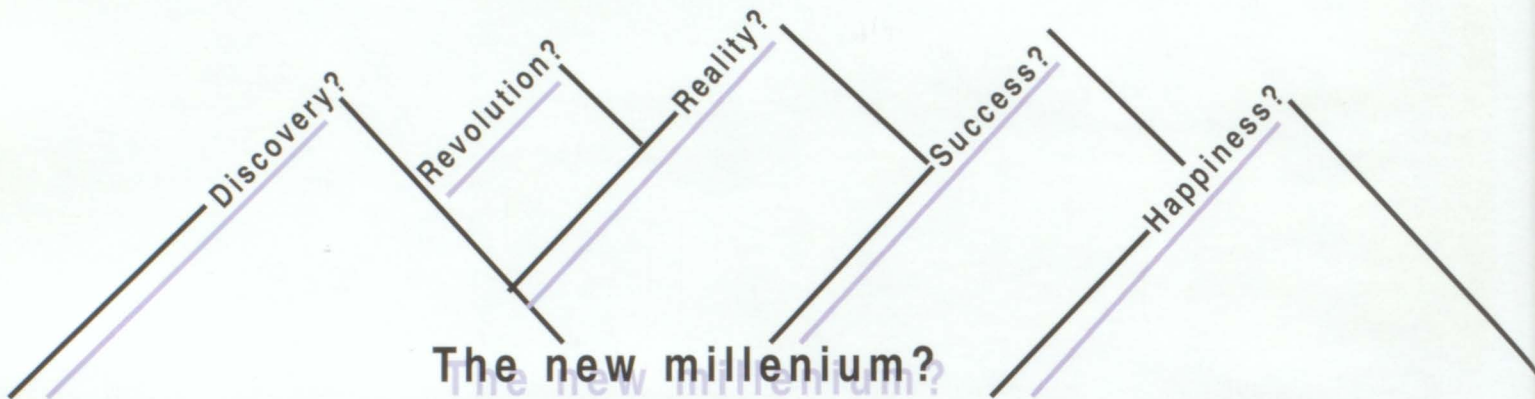

The edge of what?



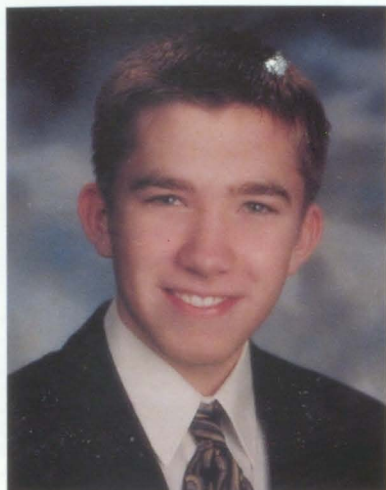

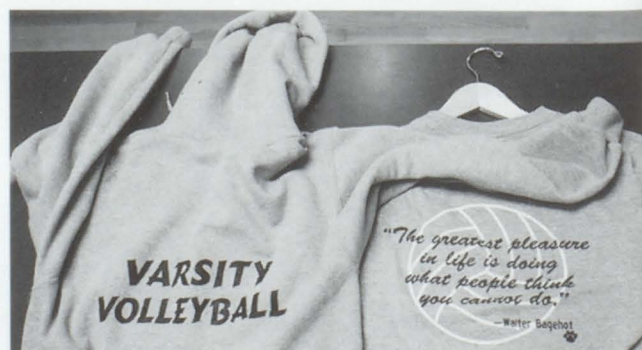

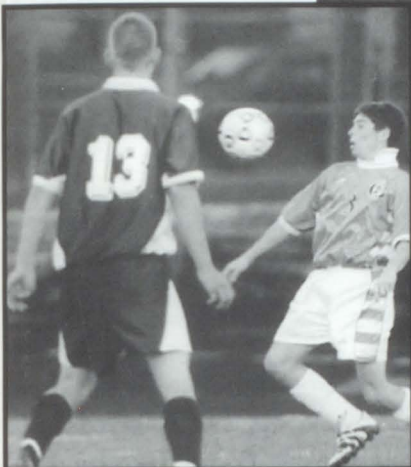

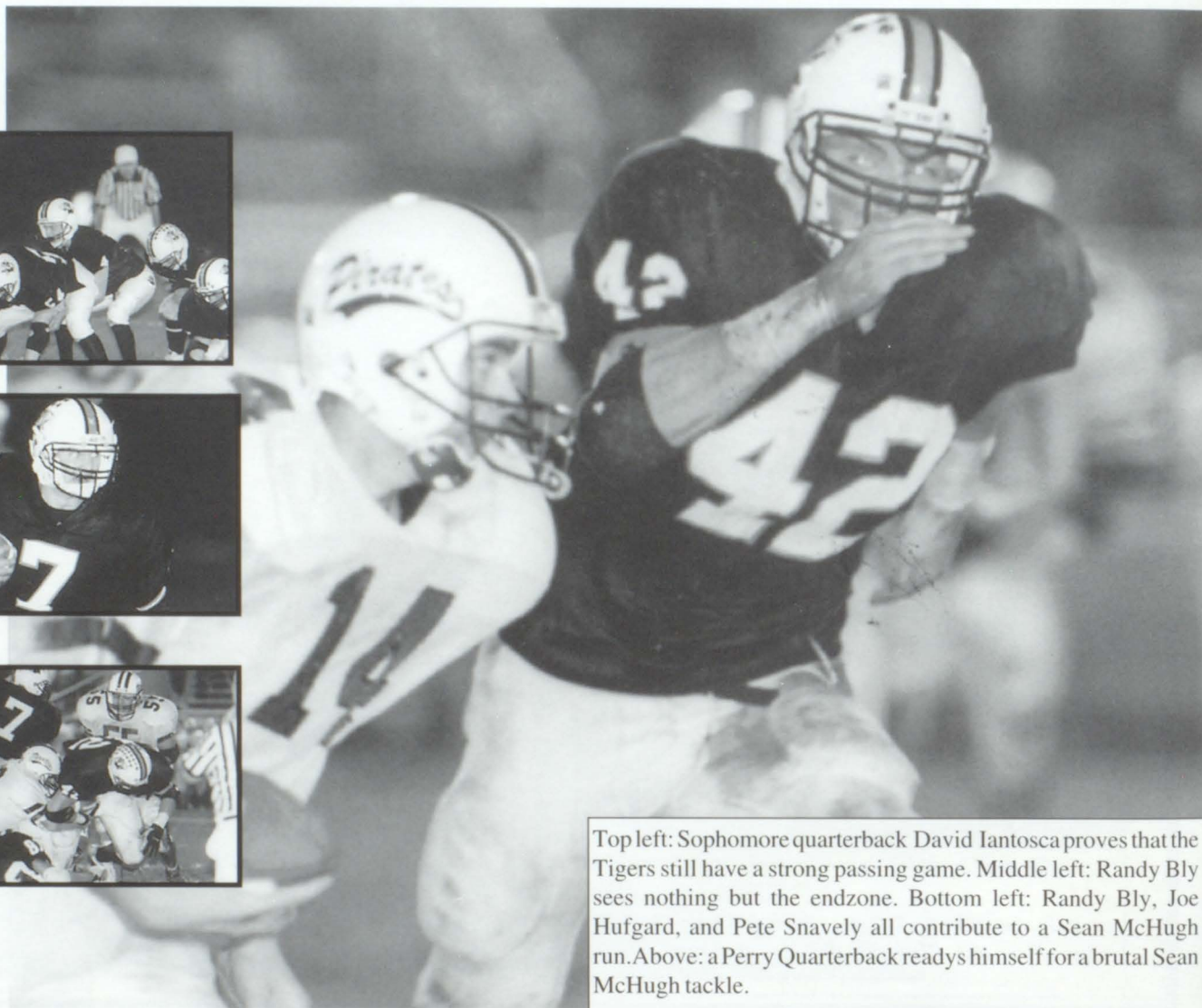

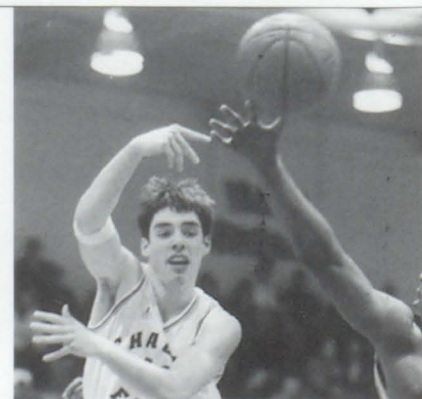

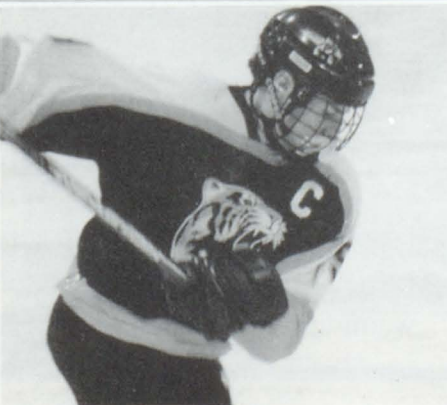

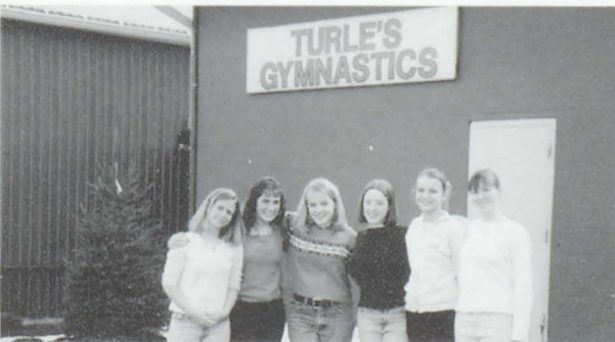

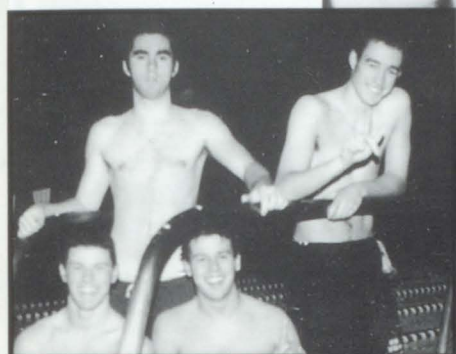

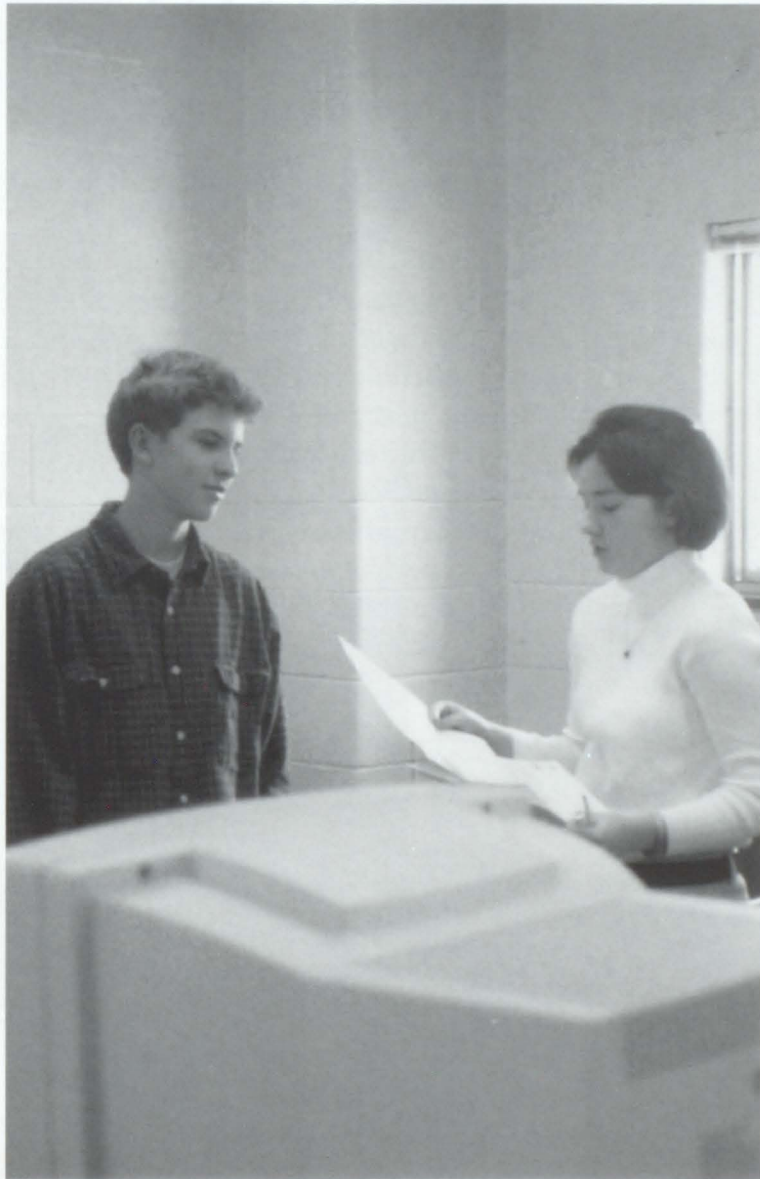


## Academics

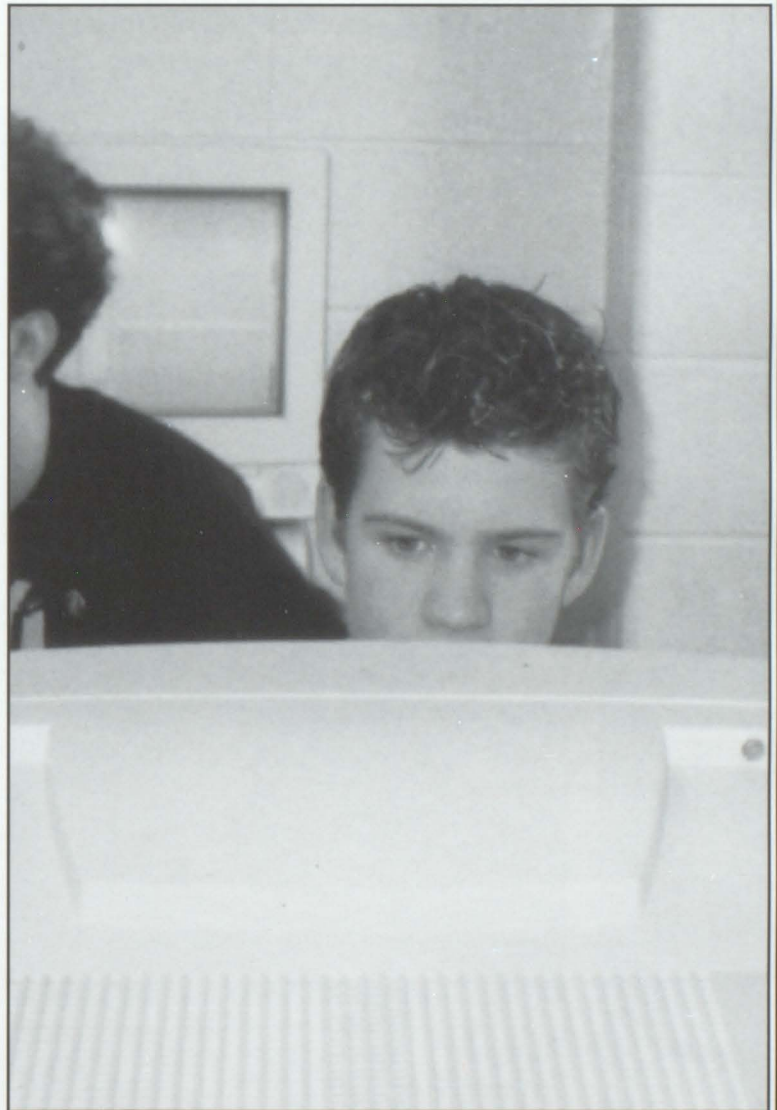
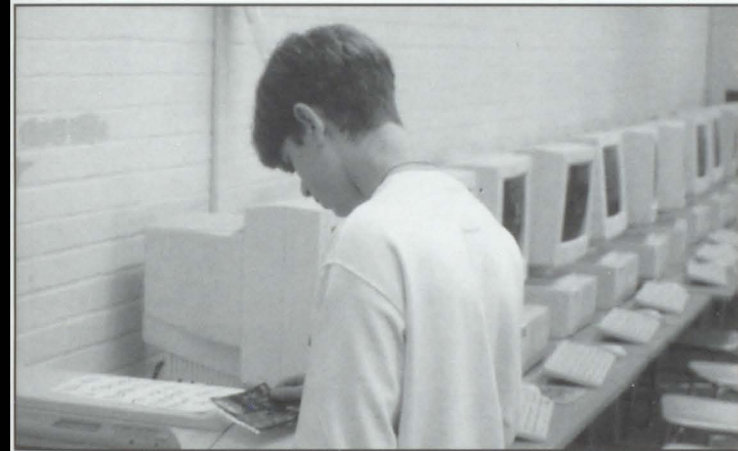




# Taking Over the World

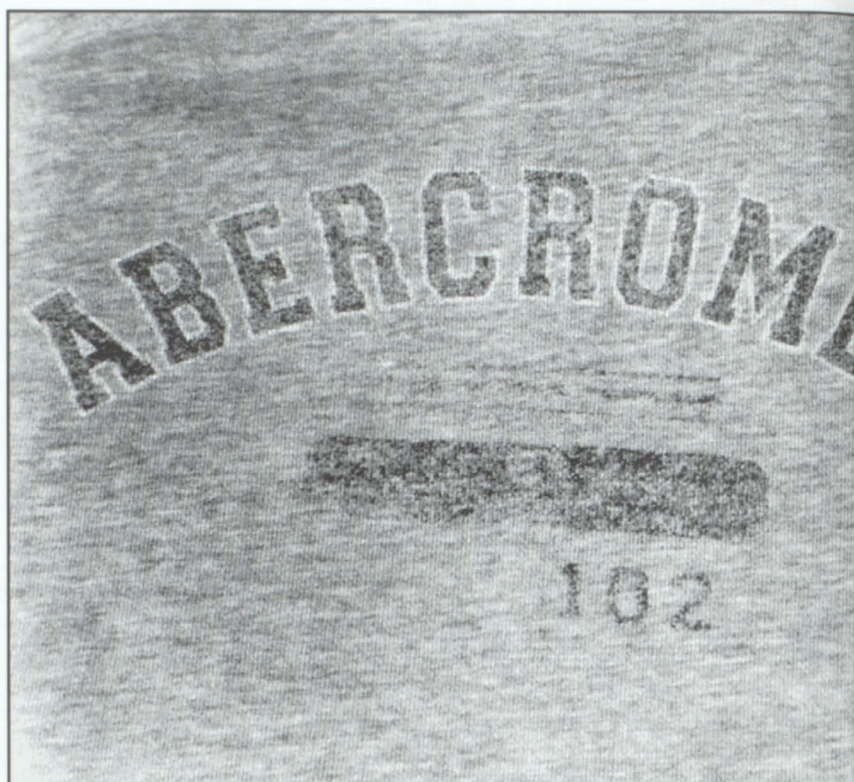
# An Integrated Year

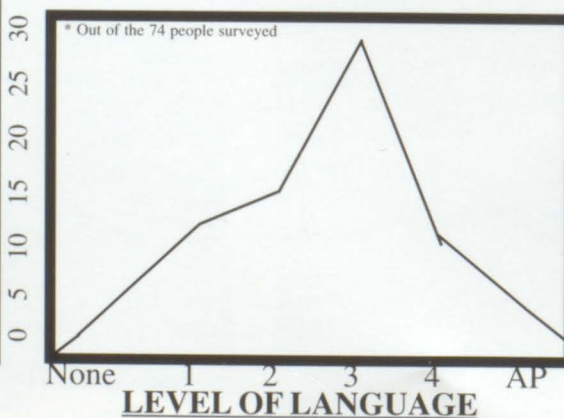

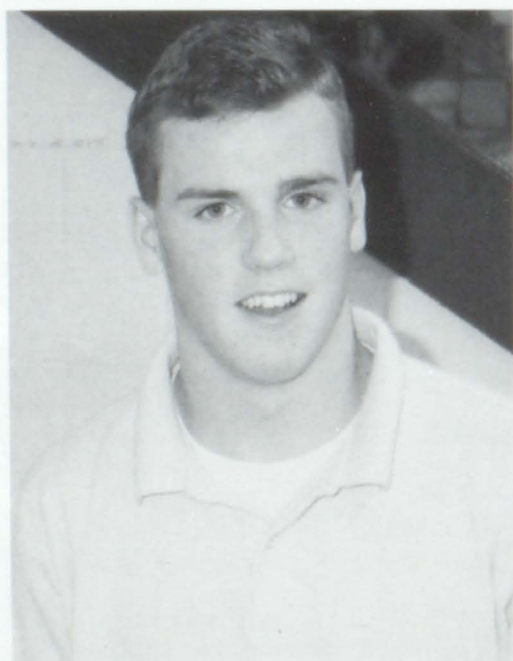
