**Meetings:** One period, every school day, after school practices and Friday night Football Games.



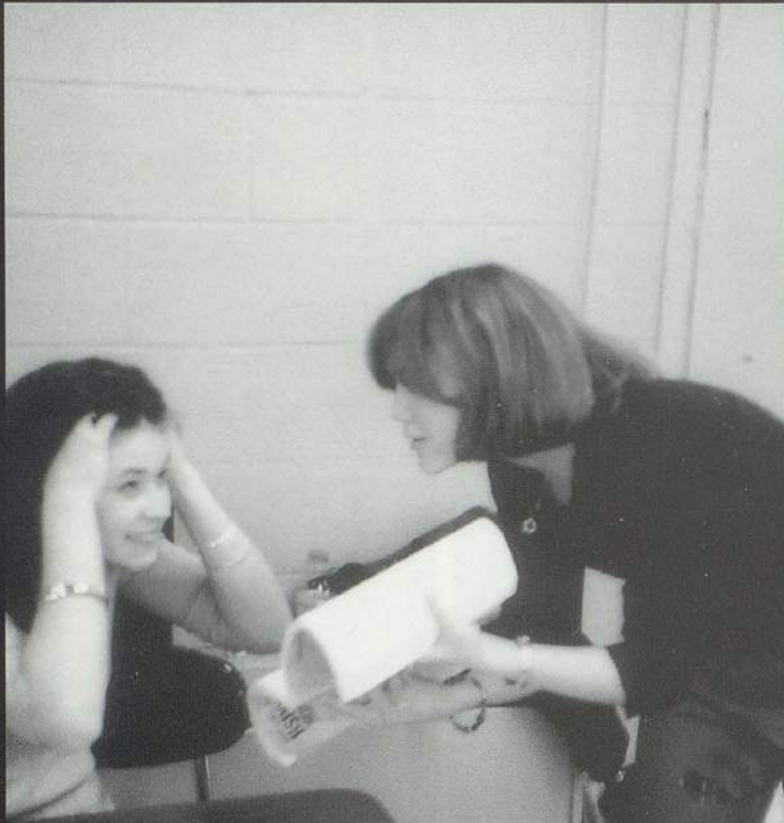

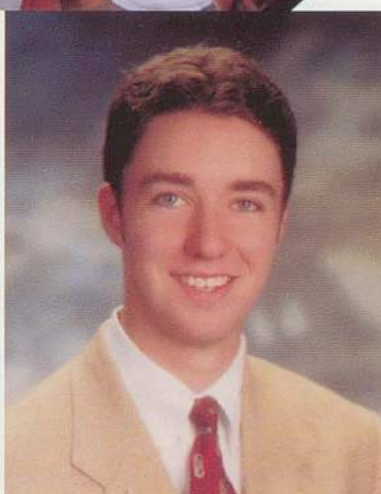
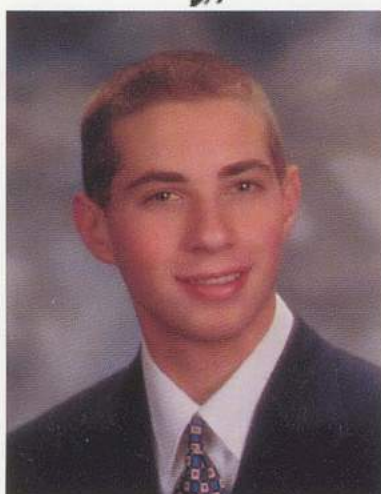
# Just Breathe...

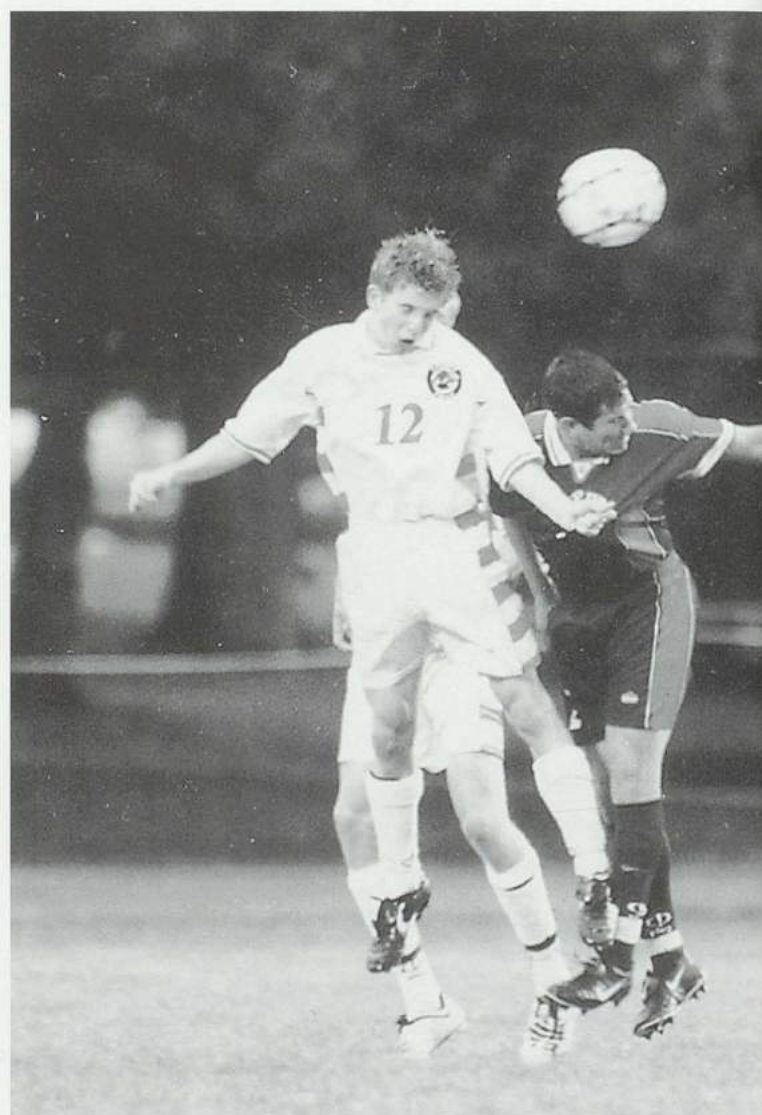

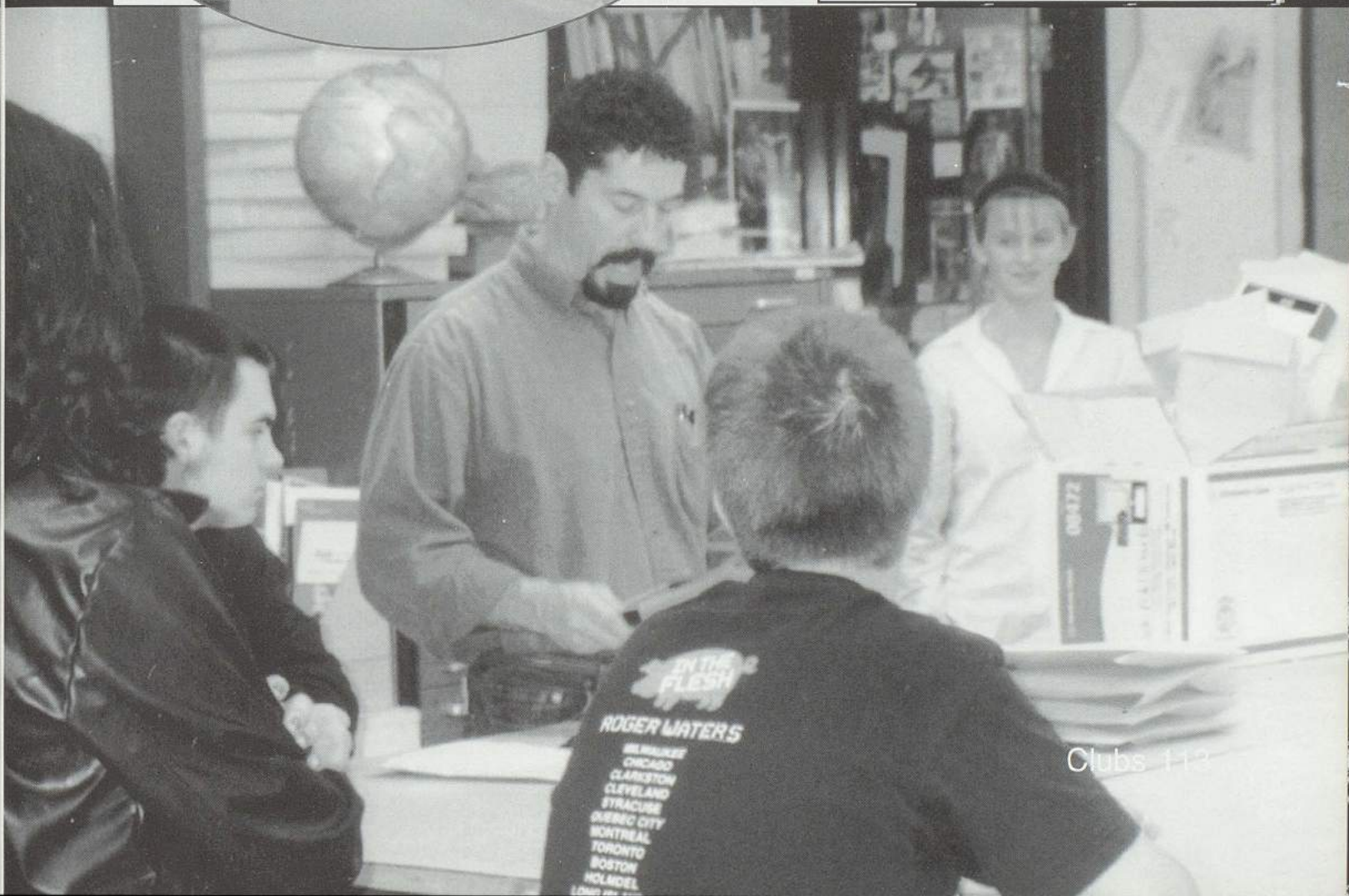

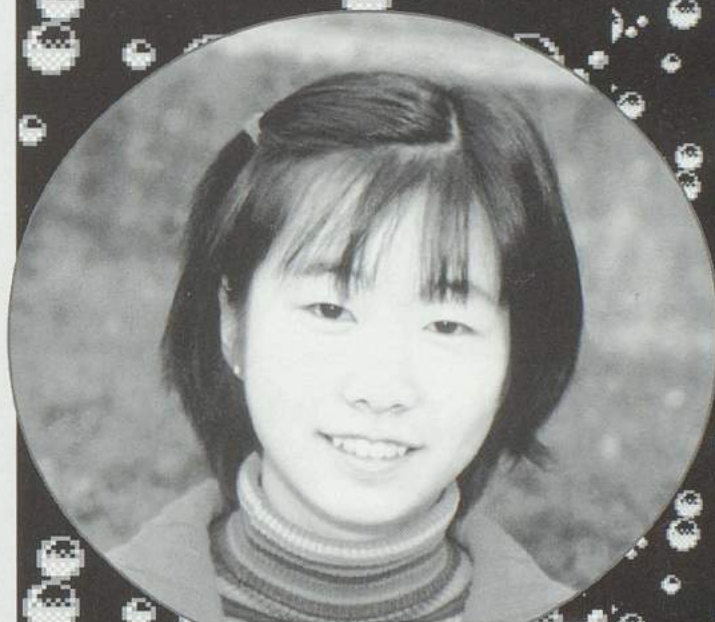

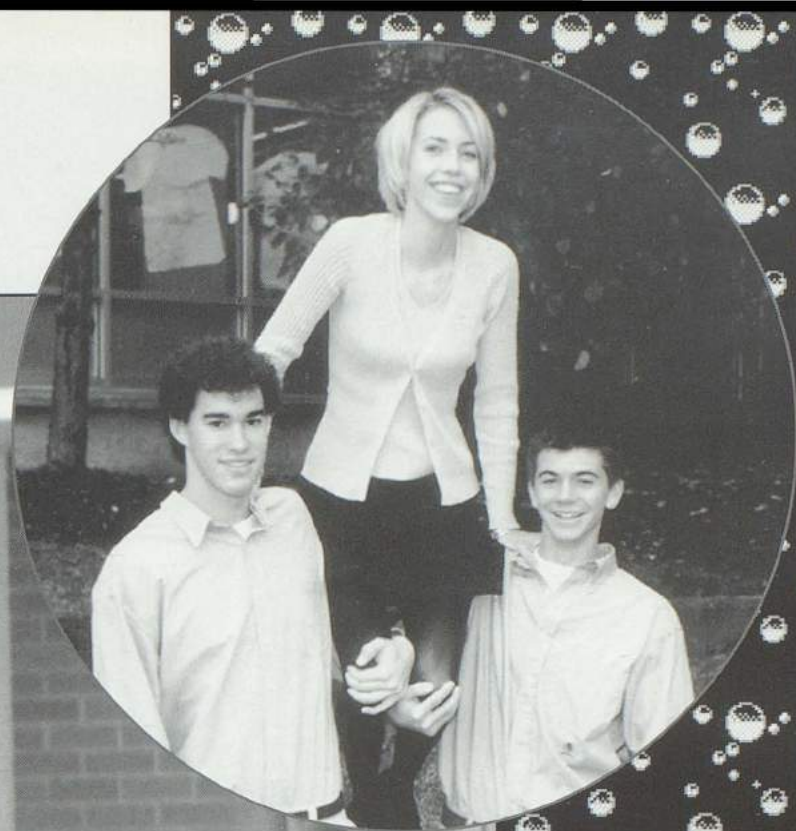

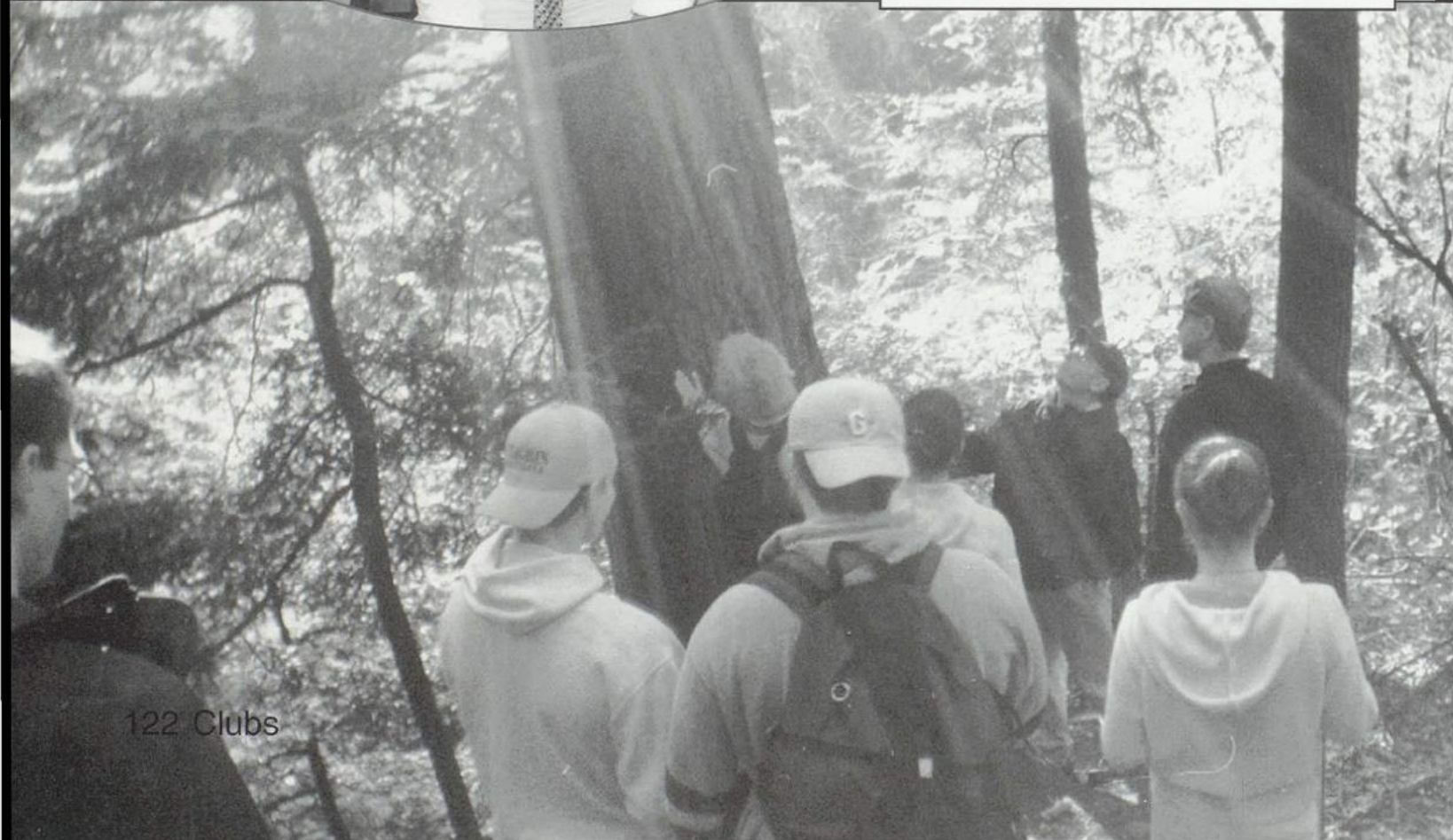
