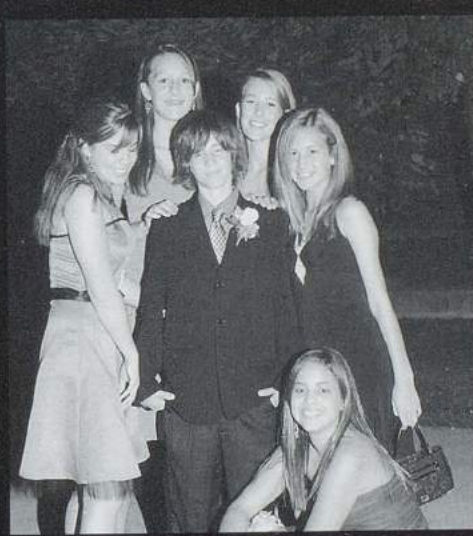
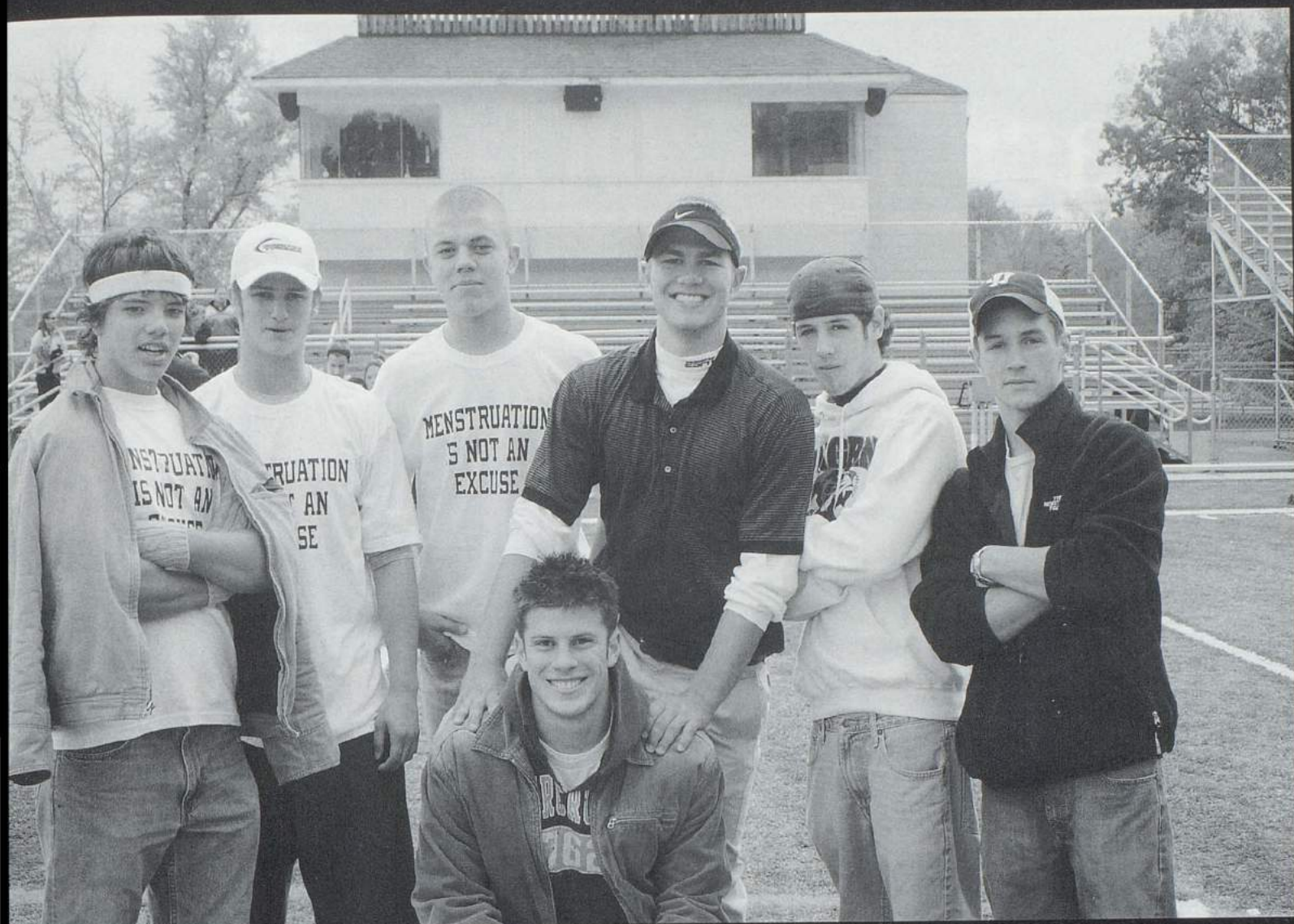
The Final Chapter

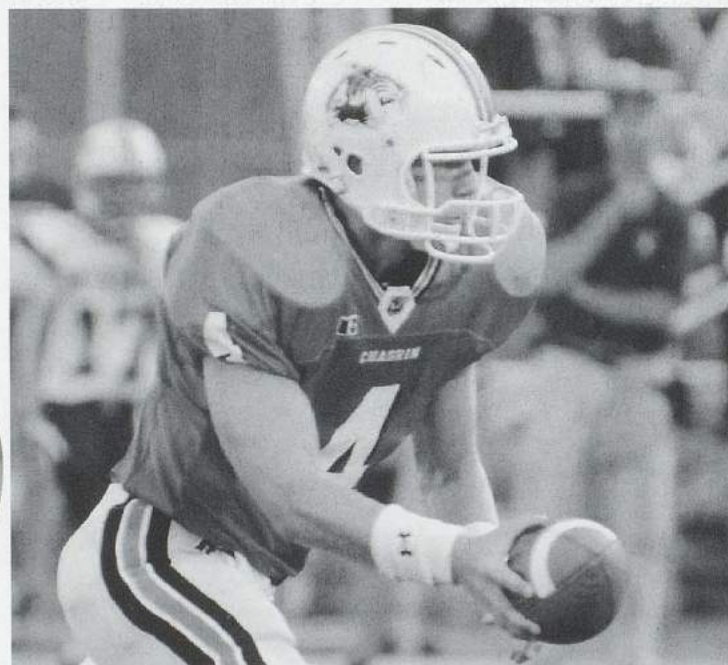


FOOTBALL

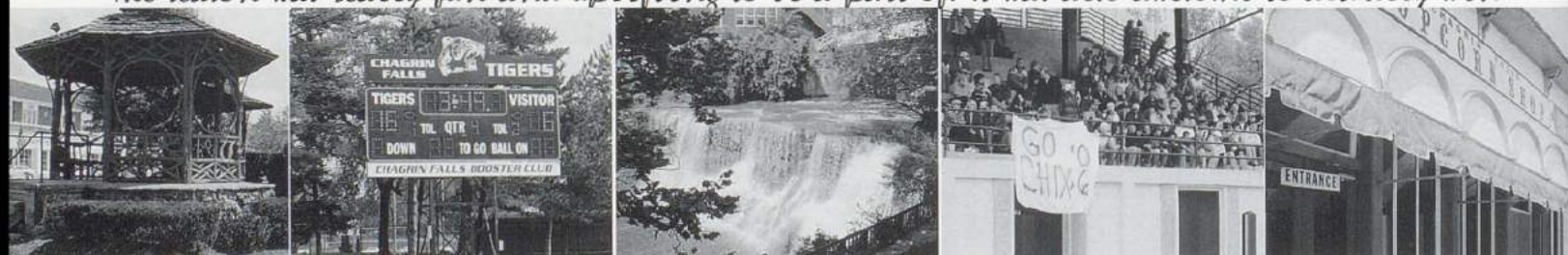

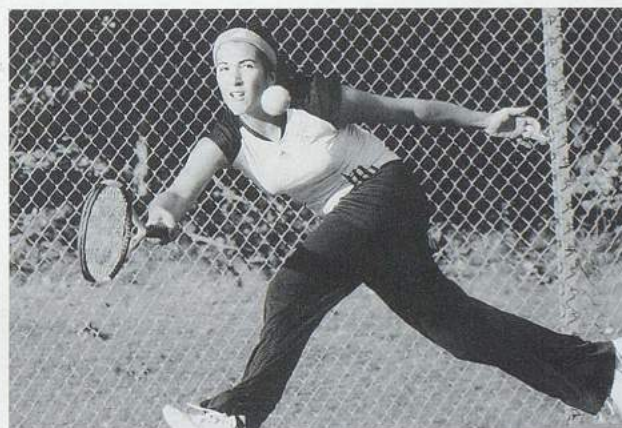

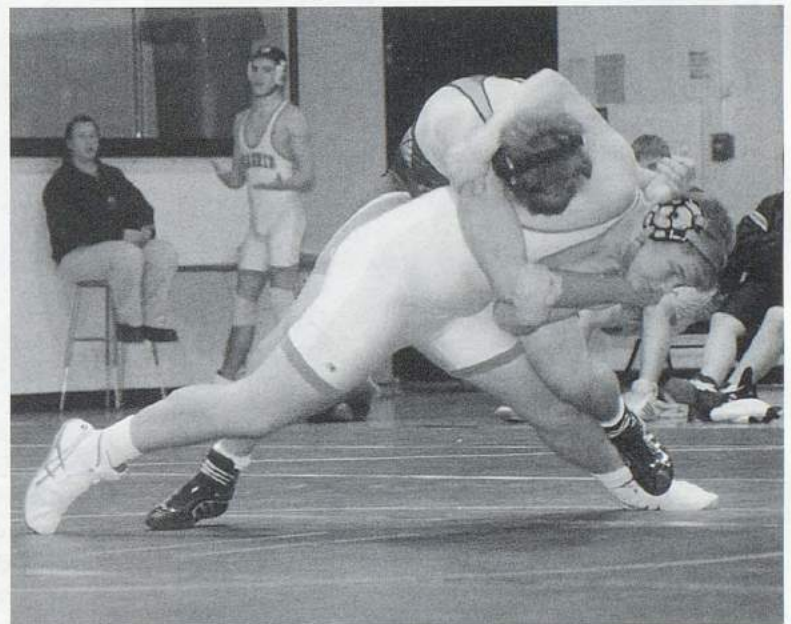

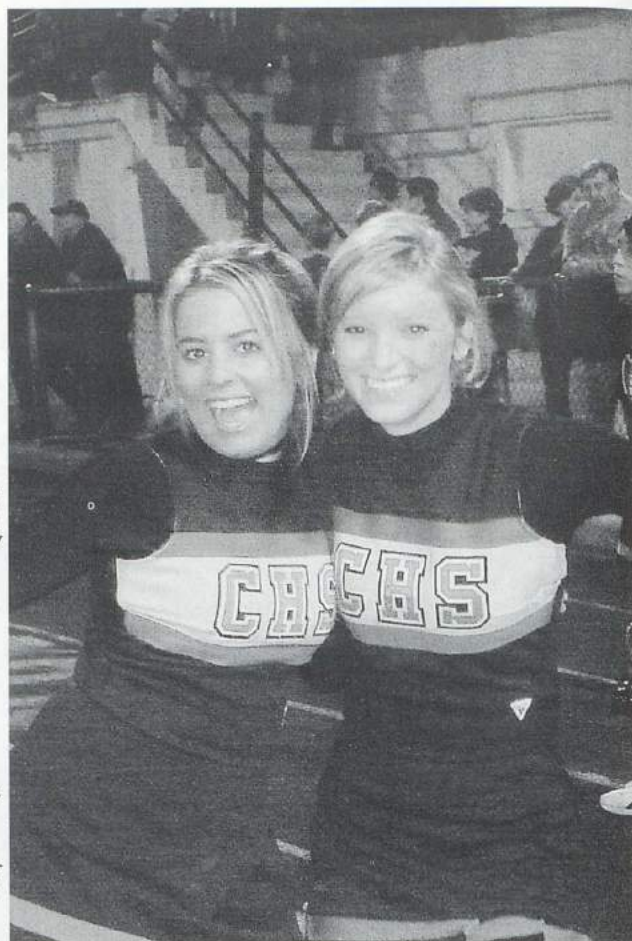

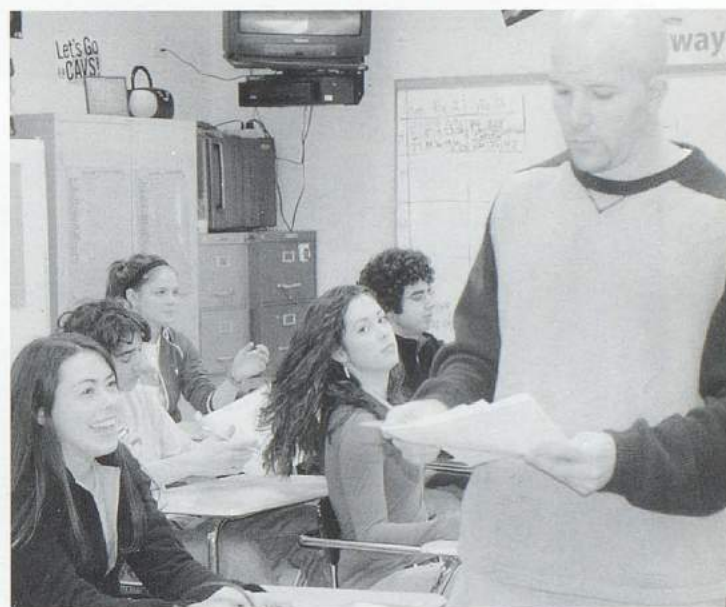

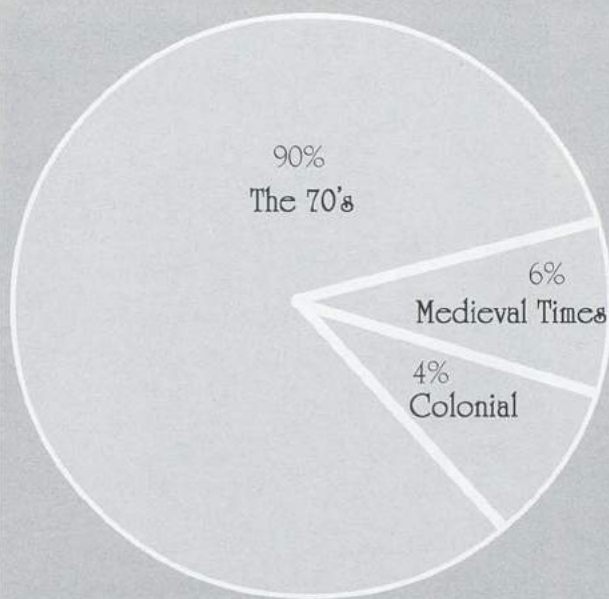

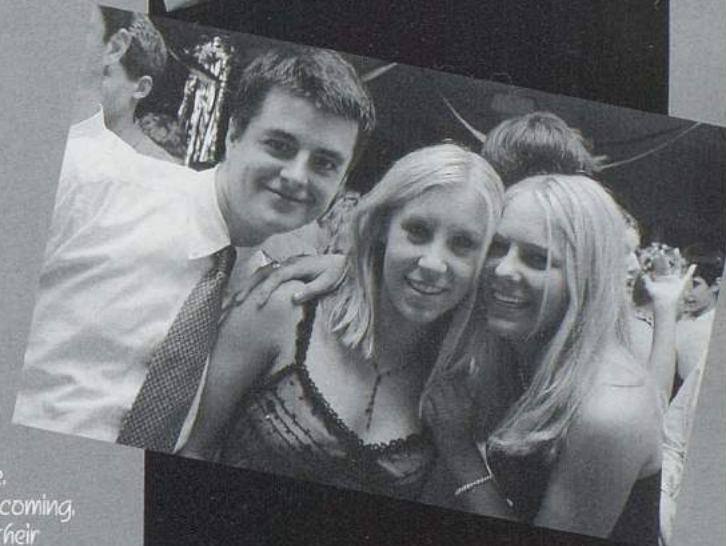
