The current students of Chagrin Falls High School continued the tradition of academic excellence throughout the 2006-2007 school year. High Advance Placement and Ohio Graduation Test scores prove the strong academic commitment that Chagrin students showcase. The Ohio Department of Education recognized Chagrin in the Supexintendent's Schools of Distinction program, which is based on the achievement of the schools' students with disabilities. Chagrin Falls High School is one of only 8 schools in the state to receive this award for the second year. The Ohio Department of Education also recognized Chagrin Falls as an "Excellent" school. This marks the $7^{\text {th }}$ straight year that Chagrin Falls Schools have been honored by achieving this designation. Only 15 schools out of 611 in the State of Ohio have achieved this success.
