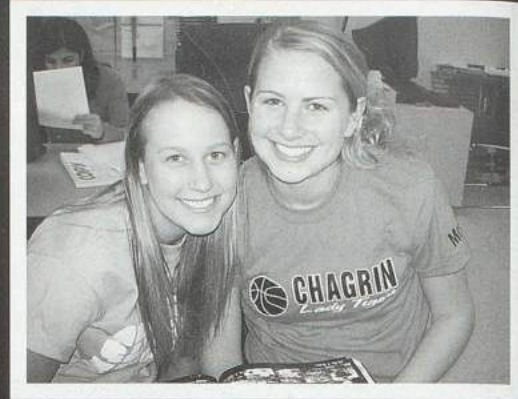
STUDENT LIFE

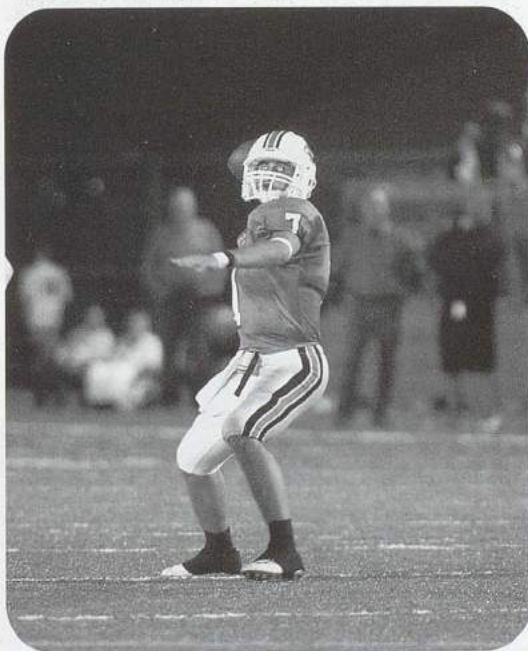

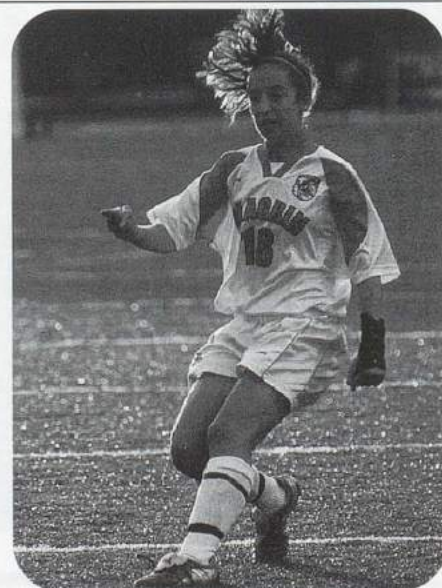

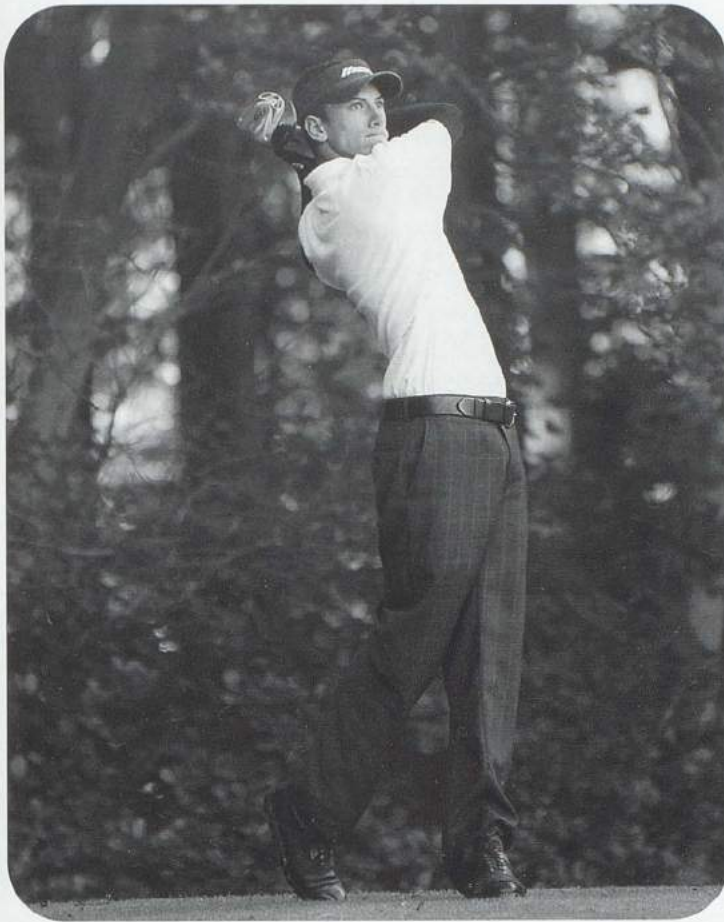

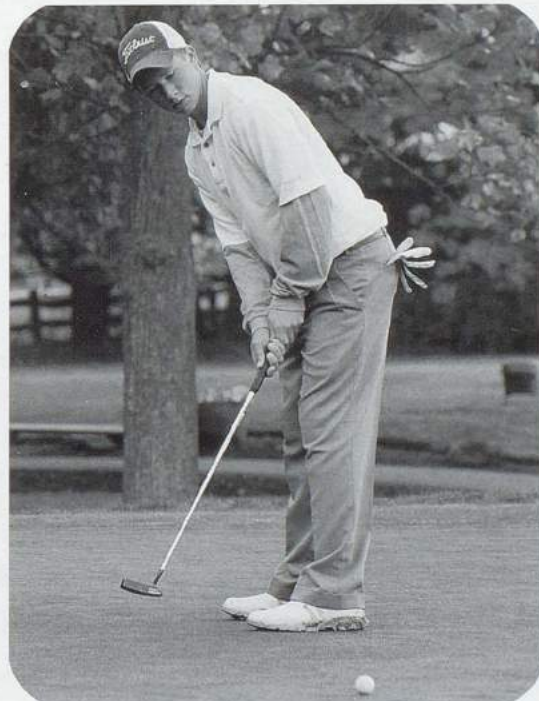

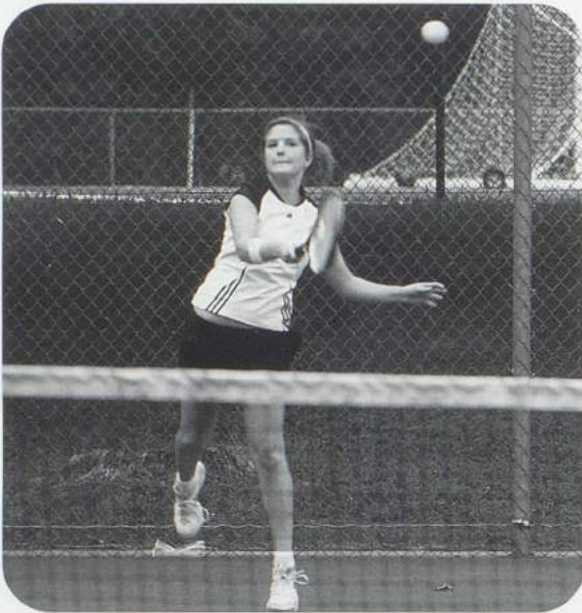

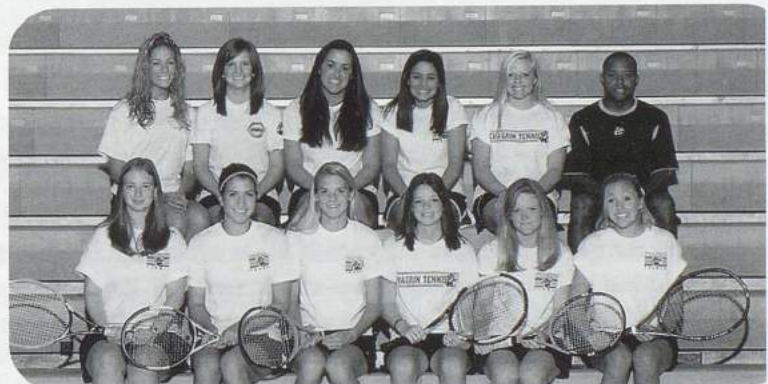

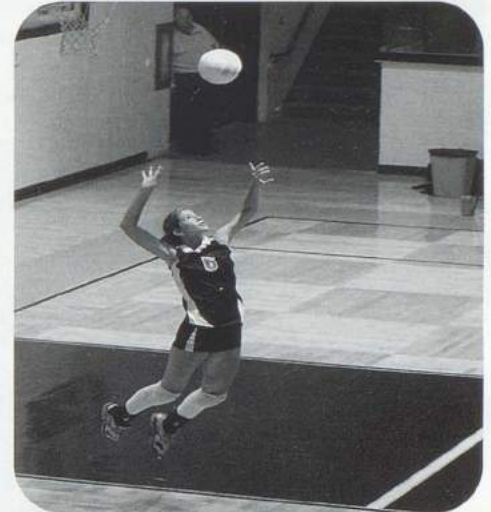

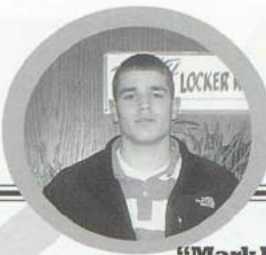

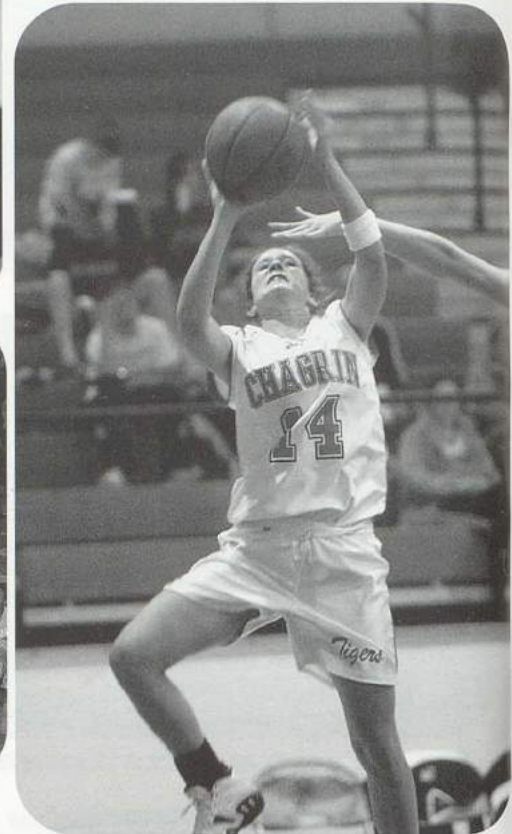

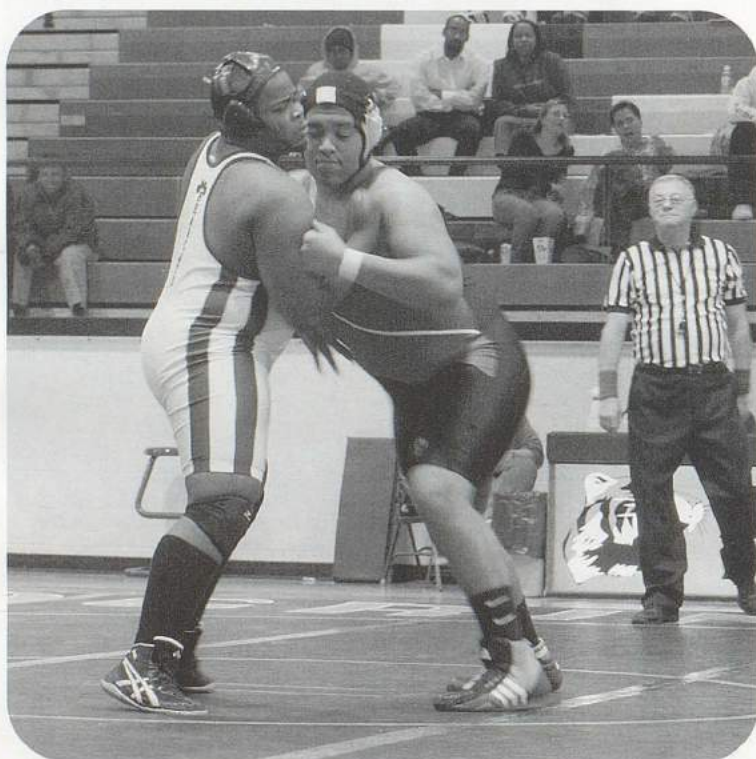

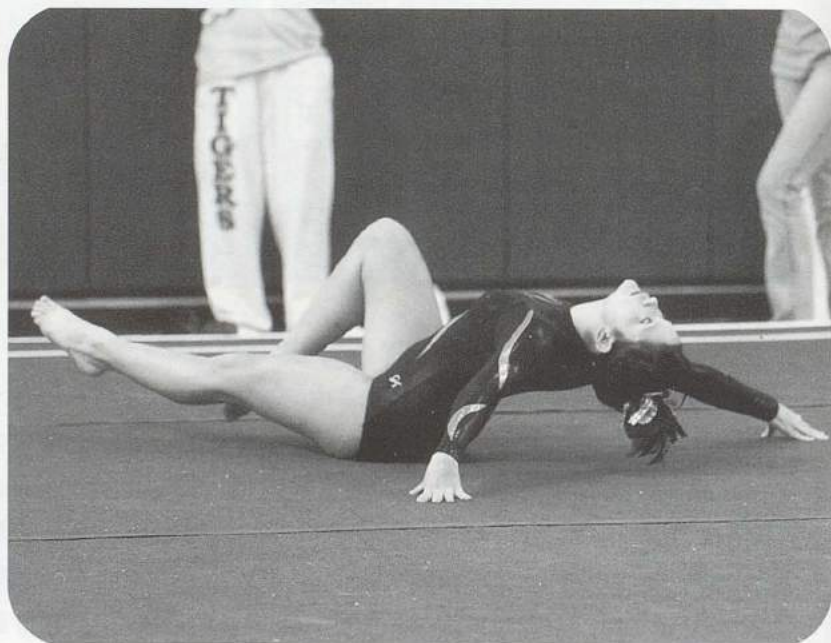
