Welcome to the 102nd edition of the Zenith, the yearbook of Chagrin Falls High School. It is my pleasure to write about the Chagrin Falls Exempted Village Schools. This edition of the Zenith details the 2011-2012 school year, the 163rd year of CFHS. You are a part of a long history of the Chagrin Falls Exempted Village Schools.

Your years at Chagrin saw the district receive many honors. Chagrin was ranked by the Ohio Department of Education as "Excellent with Distinction" for the twelfth straight year. The Intermediate School, Middle School and High School were all recipients of the National Blue Ribbon from the Department of Education, while Gurney School was honored as a Hall of Fame School. Newsweek magazine ranked Chagrin High School as the top school in Northeast Ohio, fourth best in the state and the ninety-second best school in the entire country. These awards were a result of a supportive community working together with a quality staff to provide the best possible education for you and the classes following you.

Numerous community organizations supported you throughout your years at Chagrin: the PTO, Boosters, Music Lovers, Dads' Club, Educational Foundation, O.P.E.N., Jaycees and Rotary. The small town atmosphere and local traditions created an environment that fostered a stable and caring school district. Almost 1/3 of the class of 2012 attended school from kindergarten through graduation. We often referred to Chagrin Falls as a "bubble" and it was a great place for you to learn and grow as students and as citizens.

Your high school Advanced Placement program achieved record numbers of students participating, record number of tests taken and record number of scores of three or higher. Your high school activities included, among many others, Debate, International Club and Key Club. Last year you competed in the state championship level in debate, football, gymnastics, swimming, tennis and track. In so doing, your swim team set twelve new school records. In addition, students traveled to China, Costa Rica, South Africa and Spain as part of school projects.

As you read the Zenith for the first time, savor the memories this yearbook has captured. You will refer to the Zenith many times over the course of your life. You will be surprised how some things that seem important now will not be so important later in your life. You will be surprised how friends will come and go and new relationships will develop at each class reunion. You will find that you are now helping to continue the long history, traditions and standards of the community. Some of you will become leaders of the Chagrin Alumni Association. Some will be inducted into the Alumni Hall of Fame for achievement or athletic accomplishments. No matter how your life runs its course you will always be a Tiger.

Enjoy viewing the Zenith today and in the years to come. It will serve as a reference and a reflection of your Chagrin school years. It will serve as a keepsake for your family. It will be the bond that connects you to your alma mater.
